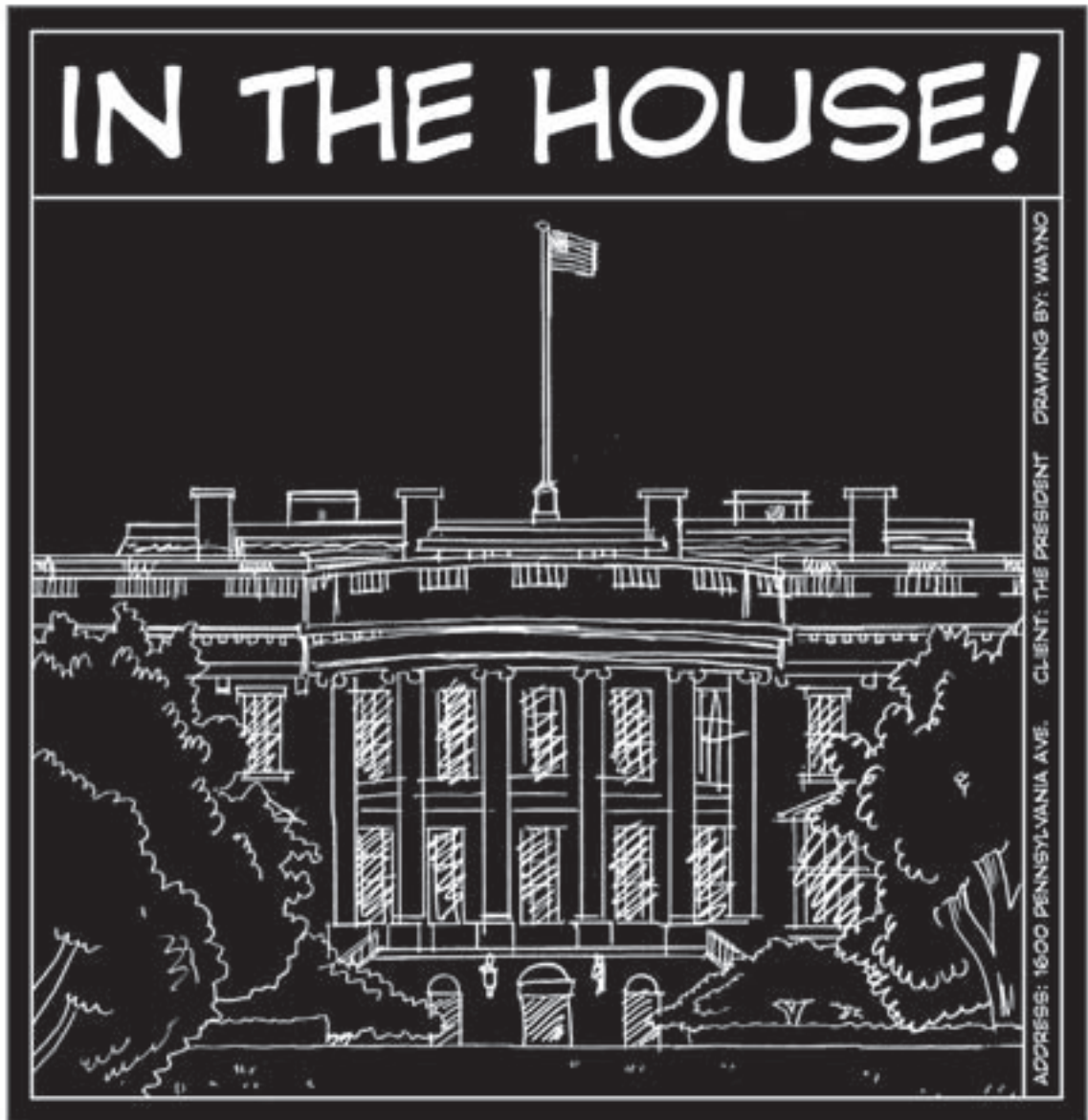

IN 1934 PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT HAD THE OFFICE MOVED TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WHITE HOUSE, OVERLOOKING THE GARDENS OUTSIDE.

AT ITS WIDEST POINTS, THIS ROOM IS 168 FEET LONG AND 152 FEET WIDE.
